Page 8: [SECTION V PROGRAM SCOPE]

Applicants **applying** for one or more program areas must address the different needs of the target population.

Page 9: [SECTION V PROGRAM SCOPE, PROGRAM ONE-SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION/EDUCATION PROGRAM]

Insert:

D. The applicant is responsible for developing and implementing urine surveillance procedures to test the client's urine. These tests should include but are not limited to the detection of:

1. **Opiates;**
2. **Methadone;**
3. **Amphetamines;**
4. **PCP;**
5. **Cocaine;**
6. **Alcohol; and**
7. **Cannabinoids.**

Page 10: [SECTION V PROGRAM SCOPE, PROGRAM ONE-SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION/EDUCATION PROGRAM]

- F. The applicant is responsible for enrolling families in a 20 hour- long patient parenting training which includes ATOD education.

This program shall target **adult** Latino/as.

5. The applicant shall maintain a multi-disciplinary team of qualified (licensed and/or credentialed) clinicians (i.e., physicians, nurses, social workers, counselors, etc);

6. The applicant shall offer physician coverage **onsite or through linkages.**

3. The applicant demonstrated the knowledge and experience relevant to assessing needs, providing treatment services for the target population and demonstrated cultural sensitivity while involving family and significant others in the **services received by the person served**. (10 points)

Page 15: [SECTION VI REVIEW AND SELECTION OF APPLICATIONS, Decision on Awards]
