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## SECOND QUARTER REPORT ON DONATIONS APPROVED BY OPGD FOR 2002

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Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2002-2 dated January 11, 2002, the Director of the Office of Partnerships and Grants Development (OPGD), in consultation with the Office of the Corporation Counsel's Ethics Counselor, has published the District's 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Report on Donations. The Order requires the OPGD Director to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor's Memorandum 2002-1) and Section 115 of the 2002 D.C. Appropriations Act. This report contains data on all donations approved by the Director for the period beginning April 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2002. During this period, the OPGD Director approved the solicitation and/or acceptance of \$160,025 in donations of which \$60,025 represented financial contributions, and \$100,000 represented in-kind contributions.
